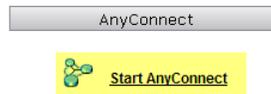

Click Yes for Java

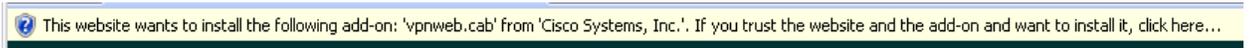

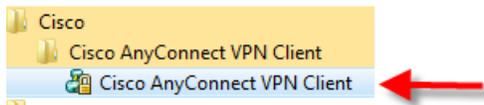
## 10. REBOOT

Within Windows, Click on your Start button. Select > All Programs>Cisco



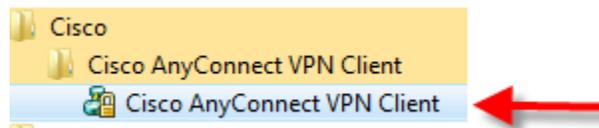
1. Click Select button.
