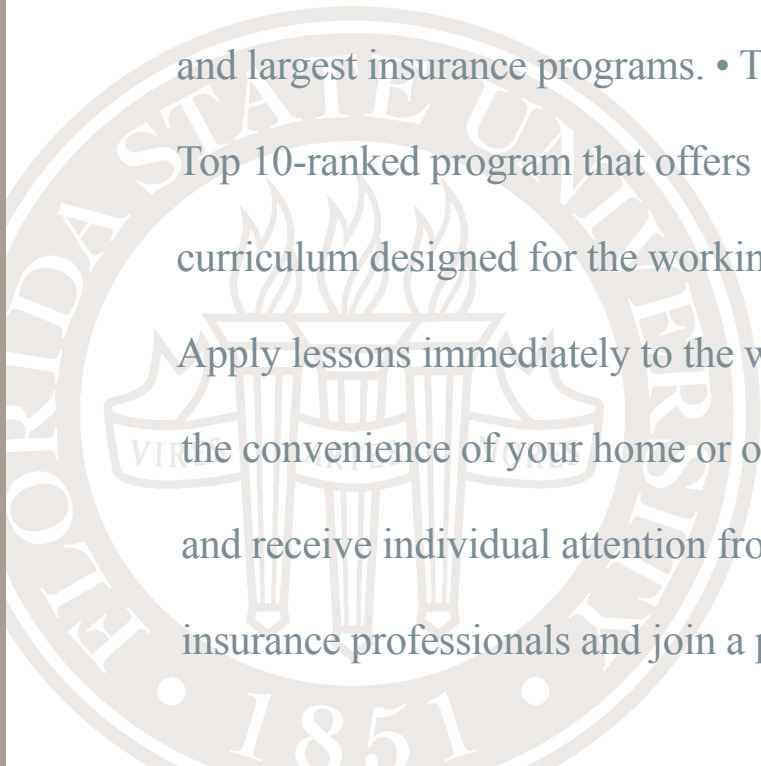

Admission guidelines

Admission to the program is highly competitive and based on the academic and professional credentials of the applicant pool. The College of Business considers a variety of factors, including work experience, prior education, GMAT scores and recommendations.

Application process checklist

Each applicant is expected to submit a completed application package to the College of Business. The admissions review committee will only review complete application packages.

Send the following items through the online admissions application (<https://admissions.fsu.edu/gradapp/>):

1. Completed University Application for Admission to a Graduate Program
2. Non-refundable application fee of \$30 (may be paid online after University Application submitted, or mail to: Florida State University, PO Box 5000 Tallahassee, FL 32314-5000)
3. Applicant Statement, including educational and career objectives
4. Current resume, clearly indicating work experience including dates and positions held
5. A letter of recommendation from applicant's supervisor that speaks specifically to candidate's ability to complete the program, as well as executive and leadership potential
