#### Steps to Complete Contract

Your contract will not be considered complete until you complete all of the following in this order:

- 1. Submit the online portion of the contract. (This is the first page of that contract.)
- 2. Within 10 days, pay the \$100 advance payment.
- If you are under 18 years of age at the time you submit this contract, you need to complete and return a <u>Summer</u> <u>Parent Signature form</u> by May 1, 2013.

#### Contract Terms

#### The following are highlights of the terms and conditions of the Summer 2013 housing contract:

- This contract creates a financial obligation for Summer C 2013.
- This contract is binding regardless of room assignment.
- This contract cannot be cancelled for Summer 2013 unless you provide written notice that you will not be attending Florida State University for Summer 2013.

The full <u>Housing Contract Terms and Conditions</u> are available on our website. They will be shown and must be agreed to on the final page of this contract.

#### Roommate Requests

Students should complete their housing contract as soon as possible. Students with completed contracts will be able to submit oommate requests between March 4 through May 1 provided that all parties have submitted a housing contract.

Once a priority number is established (after you complete this contract), you will not lose your priority number if you request a roommate; however, if you mutually request a roommate your roommate group will be assigned based on the worst priority number of the individuals in the group.

# Money – Rent Due

Florida Prepaid Housing Plan (Fall/Spring only)

### **Financial Aid**

- Disbursed on 5th class day week before rent due
- Rent paid only after tuition & fees are paid in full
- Check balance after financial aid disburses
  - View & pay rent balance on/before rent due date
  - No balance invoice sent



# Money – Other Info

## Partial Payment

- Can be made at any point before the rent due date after student is assigned
- Encouraged for students whose financial aid will not pay rent in full OR those that need to space payments out

## Late Assignments

• If assignment not made in 1st round, estimate that rent will be the community-style double rate (\$2,475/semester)
