

Steps to Complete Contract

Your contract will not be considered complete until you complete all of the following in this order:

1. Submit the online portion of the contract. (This is the first page of that contract.)
2. Within 10 days, pay the \$100 advance payment.
3. If you are under 18 years of age at the time you submit this contract, you need to complete and return a [Summer Parent Signature form](#) by May 1, 2013.

Contract Terms

The following are highlights of the terms and conditions of the Summer 2013 housing contract:

- This contract creates a financial obligation for Summer C 2013.
- This contract is binding regardless of room assignment.
- This contract cannot be cancelled for Summer 2013 unless you provide written notice that you will not be attending Florida State University for Summer 2013.

Roommate Requests

Students should complete their housing contract as soon as possible. Students with completed contracts will be able to submit roommate requests between March 4 through May 1 provided that all parties have submitted a housing contract.

Once a priority number is established (after you complete this contract), you will not lose your priority number if you request a roommate; however, if you mutually request a roommate your roommate group will be assigned based on the worst priority number of the individuals in the group.

Money – Financial Aid

Florida Prepaid Housing Plan (Fall/Spring only)

Financial Aid

- Disbursed on 5th class day – week before rent due
- Rent paid only after tuition & fees are paid in full
- Check balance after financial aid disburses
 - View & pay rent balance on/before rent due date
 - No balance invoice sent



Money – Other Info

Partial Payment

- Can be made at any point before the rent due date after student is assigned
- Encouraged for students whose financial aid will not pay rent in full OR those that need to space payments out

Late Assignments

- If assignment not made in 1st round, estimate that rent will be the community-style double rate (\$2,475/semester)
