#### JOB INFORMATION:

The Department of Educational Psychology and Learning Systems (EPLS) invites applications for a faculty position within the Department's Psychological and Counseling Services (PCS) program. The faculty member's primary contribution will be to the CACREP-accredited counselor education major in Mental Health Counseling. The faculty member will also contribute to the CACREP-accredited major in Career Counseling. Opportunity to contribute to the APA-accredited Combined Doctoral Program in Counseling Psychology and School Psychology will be available. #### RESPONSIBILITIES:

The position will involve the following: (a) research/scholarship, (b) teaching, (c) supervision of counselor education practica and internships, (d) serving on graduate student supervisory committees, (e) serving on program, departmental, and college committees, and (f) leadership in the ongoing development of the Counselor Education track in PCS.

#### QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates should demonstrate a strong commitment to research/scholarship, teaching, supervision, and professional development. Current certification or certification eligibility as a National Certified Counselor (NCC) is preferred. Current license or license-eligible as a professional counselor (LPC) or licensed mental health counselor (LMHC) in Florida is preferred. Candidates with expertise in disability or substance abuse are preferred. Candidates for this position should also have one of the following: a) an earned doctorate from a CACREP-accredited doctoral program; or b) an earned doctoral degree in counseling (non-CACREP doctoral program) or related field, and a minimum of one year of full-time employment as a faculty member in a counselor education program.

#### OTHER:

This is a nine-month, tenure earning position at the assistant or associate professor rank, with possible summer employment. The anticipated start date for this position is 8/7/2012. Salary is negotiable.
