

### **EOAS Networking**

Bringing a six-story campus building online is no small feat. Over the last seven months, ITS worked with architects and engineers to design wireless access and data and telephony network systems in the new Earth, Ocean and Atmospheric Science building, which opened in late November. ITS installed 1,500 cable drops and fed the building with 10-gigabit fiber circuits—far surpassing the standard 1-gigabit circuits used in most campus buildings—to future-proof for growing data demands. 


