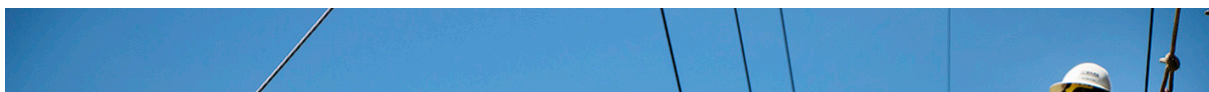

Recent upgrades to the FSU main campus network are bringing a faster, more reliable internet connection to buildings across campus. Since July 2019, two miles of fiber optic cables have been added to the university's core network, and another three miles of cable are being replaced and upgraded.

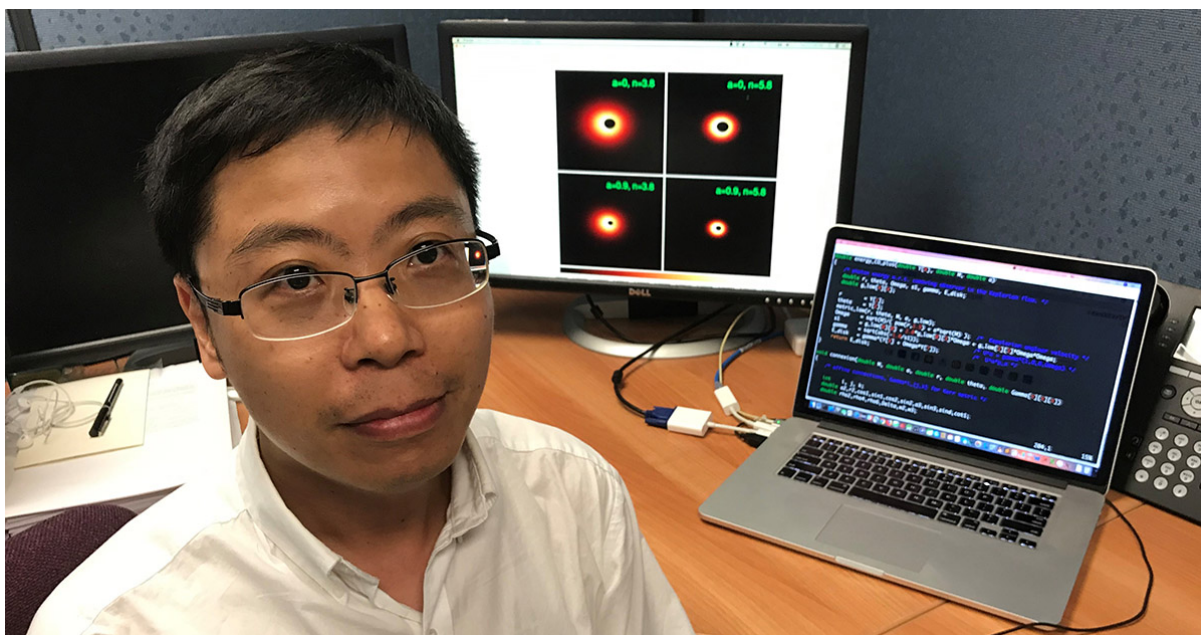


Meet Prasad Maddumage
