#### 2FA for FSU

FSU is expanding two-factor authentication (2FA) to all FSU systems, including myFSU Portal, myFSU HR, FSU email and other Office 365 applications. Within the next few months, all FSU student, faculty, staff and alumni accounts will be protected with 2FA. ITS employee accounts already have 2FA activated, and 2FA is rolling out in waves to the rest of the FSU community starting September 15 for employees, who will be activated by department, and October 26 for students and alumni.

# Training for New myFSU Service Center





#### New FL Area Code

Get ready to change how you dial. A new 448 area code will be assigned to new phone numbers in the Florida Panhandle beginning in 2021. Starting February 20, 2021, individuals will need to dial 10-digit numbers for local calls. To prepare, update FSU websites, email signatures and call forwarding numbers with the 10-digit number. This change will not affect internal FSU calls, which can continue to be dialed with 5-digits.

All Zoom meetings will soon require an additional step for entry to better control meeting security. Starting September 27, individuals scheduling a meeting will have to either enable the waiting room setting or require a passcode, with waiting room being the default setting.
