1 Set up your myFSU email account

Sign in with your email address (FSUID@my.fsu.edu) and FSUID password

Sync myFSU email to your mobile device:

2 Bookmark myFSU Portal

Add my.fsu.edu to your favorites for quick access to myFSU Portal

3 Set up 2FA

Add an extra layer of protection to your FSU accounts

Download and set up the Duo Mobile app:

4 Download Zoom

Sign in with your FSUID and password

Download the app or go to fsu.zoom.us

5 Install Office 365

Take advantage of free Office 365, including Word, Excel and PowerPoint:
its.fsu.edu/FreeOffice



6 Connect to ResNet

Plug in your device to the network port in the wall using a long Ethernet cable

Open a web browser and go to:

Sign in with your FSUID and password

7 Disable wireless printing

Connect your printer directly to your device with a USB cable



8 Connect your devices to FSUSecure Wi-Fi

Sign in with your FSUID and password

9 Download the myFSU Mobile app

10 Register your smart devices

11 Sign in to myFSUvLab
