## Beep, Beep! All Aboard the Dell Truck



# Research Uses RCC Software to Analyze Genomic Data from Loggerhead Turtles

Sea turtles are nesting along the Florida coast in record-breaking numbers this year. Ian Silver-Gorges, a Ph.D. student in the FSU Earth, Ocean and Atmospheric Sciences (EOAS) department, is studying the population structure of loggerhead sea turtles nesting along Florida's Gulf Coast—and he's using the Research Computing Center's advanced technology to conduct his research. Software installed by the RCC is used to identify single nuclear polymorphisms among the turtles. Ultimately, Silver-Gorges aims to determine if loggerhead turtle genomic data is shared between populations or fixed within populations. "Everyone at the RCC has been so helpful in making sure that I have access to, and can properly use, the software I need for my analyses on the HPC," Silver-Gorges says.
